Participants of the meeting have a great possibility to take part in Young Citizen Science Week, during which Finnish and Portuguese school children, mainly of age 13-15 present and demonstrate their projects in Environmental Monitoring. The week consists of indoor workshops and young citizen science seminars and outdoor events. During the week, it is demonstrated, how outdoor games can be connected with environmental education. There are special sessions on UAV:s and electronics in school projects.
